Longitudinal Surveys of Australian Youth (LSAY) is a program of surveys of young people conducted by ACER with funding from the Commonwealth Department of Employment, Education, Training and Youth Affairs.

Purpose of the study

The surveys focus on the educational and labour market experiences of groups of young Australians, beginning from their middle years of secondary schooling. Data collected includes basic demographic variables, as well as information about educational and labour force participation extending over a number of years.

The sample

As part of the program, a national stratified sample of 13613 students who were in year 9 at school was established in 1995. The sample design was intended to provide a sample of approximately 10,000 young people to be interviewed by telephone in late 1997. The major stratum considered in the design was state of schooling. Students from smaller states were over-sampled and, correspondingly, students from larger states were under-sampled. Selection of students within states was proportional by sector. Three sectors were used as strata: government schools, Catholic schools and non-government, non-Catholic (referred to as *independent*) schools. Within strata, schools were selected proportional to their size, with an implicit stratification by geography because of the postcode-order of the sampling frame.

Method of 1996 data collection:

In December 1996, questionnaires were mailed to 13567 persons who had been surveyed in 1995 and for whom a mailing address was available. There were two additional followup mailings to nonrespondents in the first part of 1997.
